They play an important role in preserving Bahrain's intangible cultural heritage, ensuring its exposure to younger generations.





Cendrawasih Dance

Age: Suitable for all ages Genre: Dance

Named after the rare birds-of-paradise, Cendrawasih, this Balinese dance is relatively new despite its choreography drawing inspiration from classical dance routines. The dance tells the story of life while imitating the beautiful movements of the Cendrawasih. Although the birds originate from Papua, another island in Indonesia, this special bird holds a deep meaning in Balinese culture.



Pasang Game

Age: Suitable for all ages Genre: Animation Film

In collaboration with the Embassy of Brunei Darussalam in the Kingdom of Bahrain, learn how to play the centuries-old Pasang board game. Originally played by women during wedding ceremonies, it is now played by men and children in various contexts. Pasang is made of a square board with vertical and horizontal lines in its body that form 100 cells and 120 angels, and includes a frame to prevent the tokens from falling off.



Kampong Ayer

Age: Suitable for all ages Genre: Performance

Kampong Ayer is the largest water village in the world, and is the fundamental inspiration of this performance. Held in collaboration with the Embassy of Brunei Darussalam in the Kingdom of Bahrain, this performance is a fusion of the Kampong Ayer song, portraying the life of Brunei Malays in the past, while using traditional props to symbolize this water village, along with dance moves reminiscent of their people.





El Leila El Kebira

Age: Suitable for all ages Genre: Ballet

In collaboration with the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in the Kingdom of Bahrain, the Cairo Opera Ballet Company presents El Leila El Kebira, one of the most famous musical works in the Middle East. Written by the famous poet of colloquial Arabic Salah Jahin and composed by Sayed Mekkawy, it was first broadcasted on Egyptian radio in 1957, now represented as an orchestra and lyrical dance. The performance depicts the popular festivals accompanying the birthdays of Sufi saints throughout Egypt, which usually extend over a few days and end with a great night "El Leila El Kebira" — this event is the culmination of these celebrations.

Spotlighting the Palestinian folkloric art entitled Talat, this ensemble is a source of Palestinian cultural identity and pride in the face of systematic oppression. The ensemble is keen on mixing folkinspired dance with contemporary moves, expressing the spirit of the nation from the past to present such as through reinterpretations of traditional dance patterns like Dabke, thus reflecting their special vision for a contemporary Palestinian dance.

Led by Dr. Mubarak Najem, one of the most prominent composers in the Kingdom of Bahrain and the greater Arab world alike, the band participates in royal ceremonies, military and popular celebrations. The music they perform is a blend of sounds, namely military and traditional Bahraini music.

Daqqa de Marrakech, a famous dance from Marrakesh, is one of their most prominent folk arts — it is a tradition that has been passed down through the generations for more than four centuries.

20 August Bu Maher Fort and Pearling Path Visitor Centre Tour

Discover a part of the Pearling Path, the second site in the Kingdom of Bahrain inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site list, with a tour of Bu Maher Fort and the Pearling Path Visitor Centre accompanied by Nakhool and Nakhoola! Research shows that the Bu Maher Fort traces back to 1840, and it is intertwined with the Kingdom's long history of seafaring and the pearl trade as the fort is on a beach and functioned as a port for fishing boats. The Pearling Path Visitor Centre, designed by world-renowned architect Valerio Olgeate, houses the archeological remains of two historical buildings in the heart of the ancient city of Muharraq, built back in the 1930s.



23 August Ezio Gribaudo Exhibition Tour

Visit the celebrated Italian artist Ezio Girbaudo's first regional solo exhibition at the Bahrain National Museum with Nakhool and Nakhoola. Ezio Gribaudo is an Italian artist who brings to his visionary art to life with a distinctive sense of chromatic precision and historical determination that underscores all his works as a painter, sculptor, and graphic artist. His award-winning production has been recognized with various international prizes, such as the IX Rome Quadriennale in 1965, the XXXIII Venice Biennale Prize (for graphic arts) in 1966, and the São Paulo Biennale in 1967.



30 August Post Office Tour

Tour the original post office of Manama with Nakhool and Nakhoola, renovated as a museum documenting the history of postal services in the Kingdom of Bahrain throughout the years. With content from Ministry of Transport and the Philatelic Bureau, the museum is home to an archive of photographs, a complete catalogue of Bahraini stamps as well as stamps from all over the world, a collection of vintage cancellations, scales and franking machines.
